'Potpourri' help needed

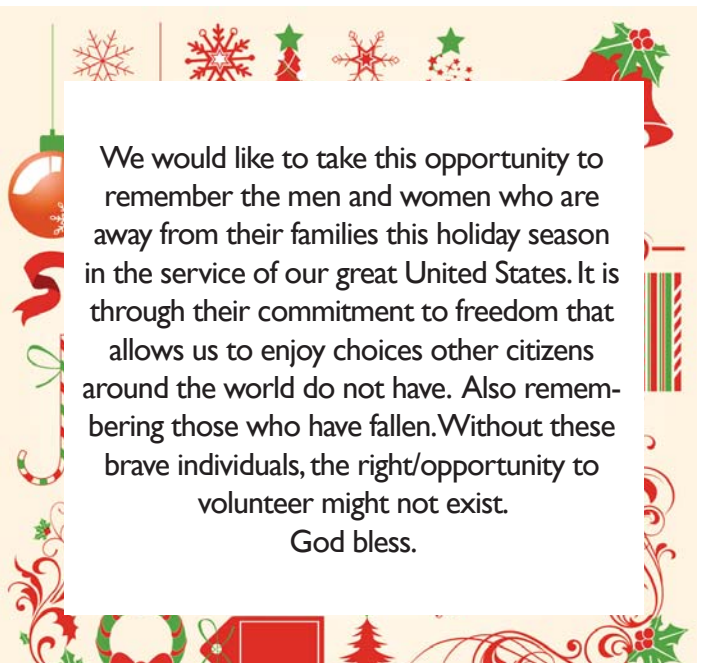
