So a new "program" has begun!

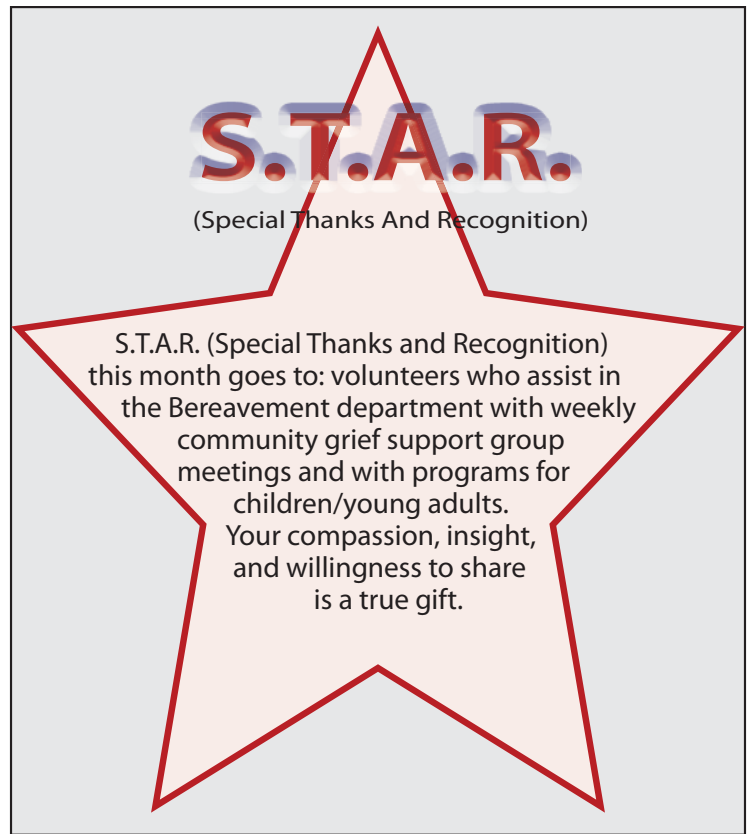
Each employee/volunteer will be receiving a new name badge at the 3,5,10,15 year marks.
